P.G. CENTRE, 'JNANA KARANJI', BIDAR**Department of P.G. Studies in Political Science**

M.A. (Political Science) course at P.G. Centre, Bidar, has been started in the year 2007-08 with an intake of 30 students. The enrolment is 09, out of which 04 are women. There are about 180 books in the P.G. Centre Library. One senior staff member deputed from the main department and two Guest Lecturers conduct the classes. Creation of infrastructural facilities and the process of recruitment of teachers are in process. The permanent faculty of the main department visit the P.G. Centre on regular basis to monitor teaching learning process.

Department of P.G. Studies in Social Work

M.S.W. course was started in the year 2007-08 at P.G. Centre, Bidar, based on the public demand and need of the area. During the year, 37 students have been admitted (21 M + 16 F). The University has appointed six guest faculty to conduct the teaching-learning process. The permanent faculty of the main department also visit the department and delivered special lecturers. Adequate number of books are being procured.

Department of P.G. Studies in Sugar Technology

The Department of Sugar Technology was started in 1996-97. Two faculty members are appointed on permanent basis. Initially there was a demand for the said course. However, during the last three years, there are no admissions. Hence, a teacher has been deputed to P.G. Centre, Bellary, to teach industrial chemistry. There is a proposal to revive the course, by creating awareness among the students about the professional nature of course. The staff members have about five publications to their credit.

Department of P.G. Studies in Urdu and Persian

M.A. in Urdu and Persian was introduced at P.G. Centre, Bidar during 1998-99. The course is managed by two guest faculty. During the 2007-08 there are five students (5 F) perusing the P.G. course. The department has recorded 100% success rate and two students have cleared NET/SLET. About 500 books of Urdu and Persian have been made available at P.G. Centre, Library. The permanent faculty of the main department visit the P.G. Center and deliver special lecturers related to the curriculum.
